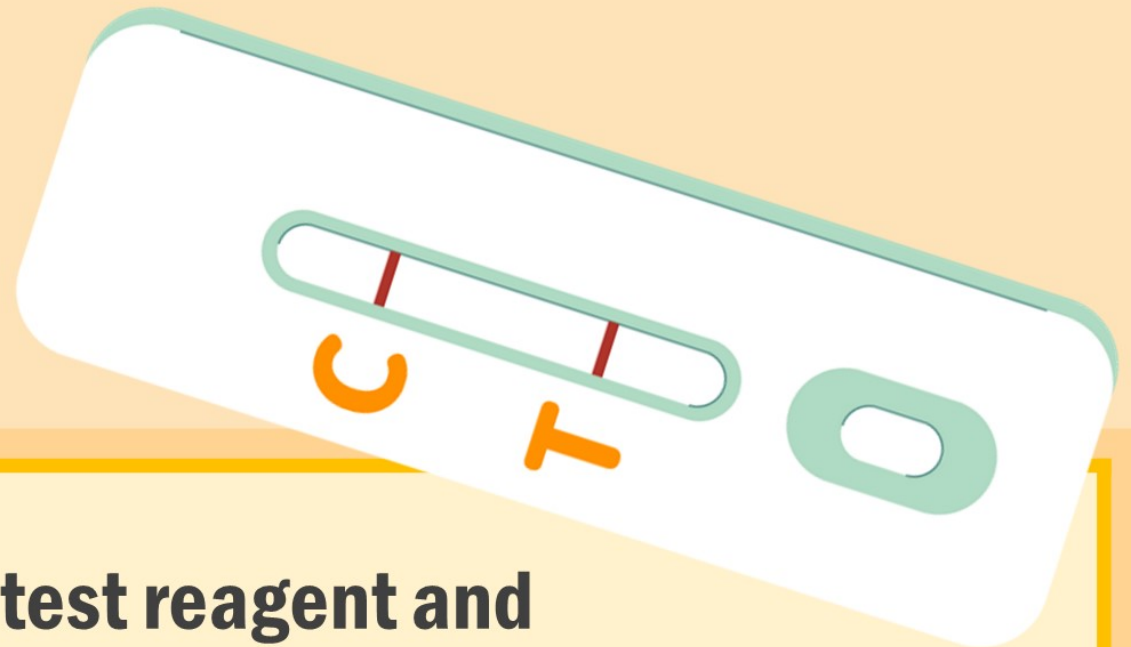

Seal the COVID-19 rapid test reagent and contact your employer or labor broker so they can make arrangements for you to receive a PCR test at a hospital

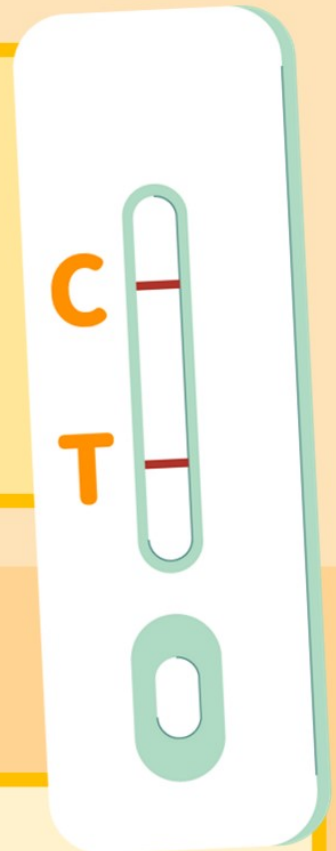


Do not use public transport

If my COVID-19 rapid test comes back “positive” what should I do?

Employers must arrange **on-site isolation** facilities at the company where foreign workers are employed or in their dormitories, where they can wait for the result of a COVID-19 PCR test



COVID-19 PCR test **positive**

During the isolation period, the employer or labor broker must arrange for a medical facility to provide telemedicine services. **If a foreign worker develops medium to severe symptoms medical treatment should be sought immediately**

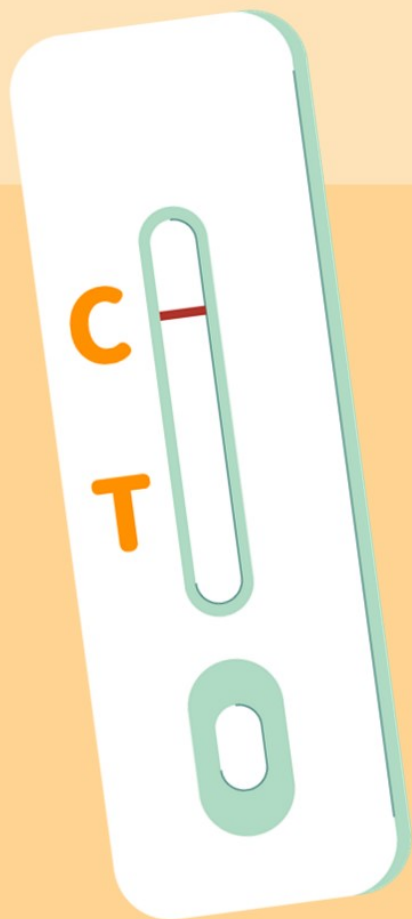
