signed as proof.**



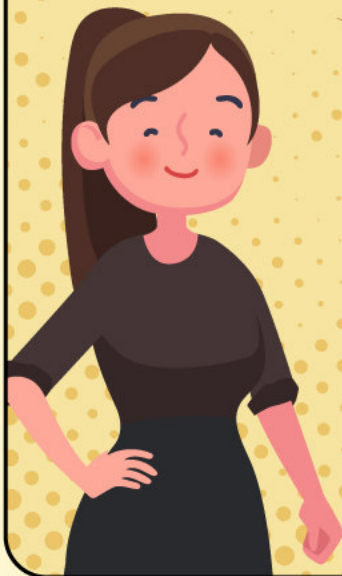
**You look so happy today,

If changes are made to your salary or work requirements during the contracted work period, a contract addendum should be drawn up and signed in Chinese and your native language. You should keep this document for future reference.
